Our scholarship is named for Lester Shick and James Hebermehl, two individuals who played significant roles in service to the credit union and its mission.

Scholarships will be awarded to qualified graduating high school seniors, undergraduate college students, and equivalent trade program students. Awards are for \$500 per academic year and are renewable for up to a total of four years, or the remaining term of the program of study, whichever is LESS.

Qualifications

- 1. New applicants must be a member of EPFCU or the son/daughter of a member.
- 2. Students wishing to renew an award must submit a transcript (unofficial is acceptable) and proof of enrollment for the next semester by July 1.

Instructions

- 1. Complete application, including short answer and short essay questions.
- 2. Attach a copy of your current transcript to the application form.
- 3. Turn in complete application to either EPFCU branch by APRIL 1.
